This year the Russian Ballet of Orlando will delight children and adults. Adding further excitement to the evening will be magic and puppet shows, face painters, balloon artists and lots of yummy treats.

Festival of Trees is the premier holiday event in Central Florida and is orchestrated by the Council of 101. An annual event since 1986, it provides the community with a truly inspiring holiday experience. This year's stunning transformation of the museum centers on the theme "Home for the Holidays" and runs from November 14, through November 22, 2009. Daily hours are 10am to 5pm with new extended hours from 10am to 8pm on Thursday, November 19 and Saturday, November 21. Daily general admission is \$10 for adults and \$6 for children. On-site parking is available for \$5.

Festival of Trees features a wide range of special events, including the Opening Night Party "Home for the Holidays" on November 13, 2009 and the ever popular Jazz Stroll on Friday, November 20, 2009.
